### Day 1: Denver to Glenwood Springs



This morning, board the Rocky Mountaineer in the scenic city of Denver, situated at the foot of Rocky Mountains in Colorado. As your train pulls out of Denver and travels westward, you'll be taking in the scenic views of the Gross Reservoir Dam. Travelling through the Rockies, the train will slowly gain elevation before reaching the Continental Divide, cutting through 10 kilometres (6.2 miles) of mountainous terrain via the Moffat Tunnel. Your Rockies to the Red Rocks train journey will continue along the Colorado River through more rugged landscapes and canyons, including the picturesque Byers and Gore canyons. Keep your eyes peeled and camera ready for wildlife, as you may get a glimpse of some native to these canyons. Later this afternoon, you will arrive at Glenwood Springs for a relaxing overnight stay.

### Day 2: Glenwood Springs to Moab

Today, your Rockies to the Red Rocks journey begins with the train heading southwest. You will pass mountain vistas and desert cliffs. Impressive landscapes continue as you pass by Parachute Creek and Mount Logan towards De Beque Canyon, a 24-kilometre-long (15 mile) narrow canyon with stair-step cliffs of sedimentary rock layers. As the journey continues west, you'll pass by Mount Garfield, the highest point of the Book Cliffs. These sandstone cliffs and mountains stretch 320 kilometers (200 miles) from east to west and mark the crossing from Colorado to Utah. Breathtaking red rock gateway to Utah's Mighty 5 national parks.

Guests enjoy delicious hot entrées served to them in the comfort of their seats. Both GoldLeaf Service and SilverLeaf Service guests enjoy gourmet meals and storytelling by our onboard host team. No matter which class of service is chosen, all guests will get to experience the jaw-dropping scenery and so much more.
- What is SilverLeaf Plus:** - Enhance your onboard experience with SilverLeaf Plus, which includes all the benefits of our exceptional SilverLeaf Service, plus exclusive access to our newly renovated lounge car. Featuring signature cocktails, the lounge car offers additional space indoors to relax and soak in the scenery as it passes you by, as well as a small outdoor viewing area. Also, enjoy an elevated dining experience with an additional course during select meals, and premium alcoholic beverages.
- Does RMR have Sleeper Cars** - No. Our daylight rail tours through the Canadian Rockies and American Southwest are scheduled to show guests all the scenery. After a day onboard the train, guests overnight in

comfortable hotel accommodation. Clients, depending on the journey booked will sleep overnight at hotels in Kamloops, Quesnel, or Glenwood Springs as the case may be.

- **Transfers at Kamloops, Quesnel, and Glenwood Springs** – Transfer from RMR Rail Station to hotel and back next day morning is offered by RMR and included in the cost of the package.
- **Who are RMR/s hotel partners?** – RMR partners with a number of [hotel properties](#) ranging from comfortable accommodations with restaurants on the property or within walking distance, to luxurious hotels and resorts with premium room categories. The hotel in Kamloops is only assigned post confirmation of the booking.
- **Hotels in Kamloops, Quesnel, and Glenwood Springs** – guests will stay in moderate, clean, and comfortable accommodation with essential amenities and great service. The accommodation is assigned to guests a few days before their departure and will be shown on their boarding pass when they check-in to board the Rocky Mountaineer train. Please note, specific bedding types cannot be guaranteed in these destinations due to limited availability.
- **Would we have access to our luggage at the overnights stops at Kamloops, Quesnel, and Glenwood Springs** – Yes. You will have access to the luggage at your hotel. You will not have access to the luggage once you have boarded the train. Clients must carry their medication in their handbags, so they have access to same while on board.
- **How are seats assigned?** – When you check in, you will receive your pre-assigned seat and overnight accommodation in Kamloops, Whistler and Quesnel, or Glenwood Springs. If you have a special seating request, such as sitting near a friend who has booked separately, please advise us at least 45 days in advance. Please note – we are unable to accommodate specific seat or coach requests.
- **Is there a Meal Plan?**
  - **Onboard Meals** – As part of our rail travel package, Rocky Mountaineer guests are served hot, gourmet meals with gourmet snacks and complimentary alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages while onboard Rocky Mountaineer.
  - **Optional Meals for Hotels** – Additional meals for the entire vacation package may be added with the purchase of a meal plan.
    - One of the most popular add-ons, hotel breakfasts offer a wide selection of delicious items to choose from.
    - Dinners include an appetizer, entrée, dessert, and a non-alcoholic beverage.
    - Server gratuities are included in both breakfast and dinner meal plan pricing.
- **Will there be a range of culinary options available to meet dietary requirements?** Our onboard menu will have a selection of options to cater to various tastes and requirements. If you have a specific dietary requirement, either an allergy or restriction, please inform us directly or through your travel professional at least 60 days prior to the train departure.

- **Can children travel on rocky mountaineer?** Yes, however, depending on the rail route, a day onboard the train can be up to nine hours, which may be long for some children, and is not recommended for infants.
- **Is smoking permitted on the train and in the hotel rooms?** – To ensure the preservation of the fragile environment of the areas in which we travel and for the comfort of all guests, there is a “No Smoking or Vaping Policy” of any kind including cigarettes, cannabis, cigars, and e-cigarettes onboard Rocky Mountaineer, including vestibules, restrooms, inside the station, on the platforms or near the tracks. There is also no smoking in hotel rooms. We recommend that you prepare for the journey accordingly.
- **Do we have to tip the onboard hosts?** – Gratuities for the onboard host are not included and optional. A recommended tip would be \$50 per client per day.

Gratuities are not included in prices (unless indicated) for Rocky Mountaineer Hosts, driver-guides, transfers, tour escorts, or hotel portage, with the exception of Rockies to the Red Rocks packages where hotel portage is included in the pricing. While it is neither our place nor our wish to tell you how much to tip, gratuities in North America are often given in recognition of service excellence. You can find a recommended breakdown based on class of service and journey in the online FAQs section at <https://www.rockymountaineer.com/faq/onboard-experience>. If you are travelling on an organized tour, you may want to check with your Tour Director to confirm if gratuities have been included in your tour itinerary with your Tour Director.

- **Am I able to move around onboard Rocky Mountaineer?** One of the advantages of train travel is the spacious room afforded to all guests. We allow safe movement through your own coach, including an outdoor viewing area to enjoy fresh air, that is accessible only to guests in your coach.
- **Am I able to bring my pet along?** All pets or animals (excluding qualified service animals) are prohibited from travelling onboard Rocky Mountaineer. If you wish to travel with your service animal, please notify your Vacation Consultant or travel professional at the time of booking, or a minimum of 60 days prior to commencing travel with Rocky Mountaineer.
- **Can we book flights with Stars & Maple Holidays** – Yes. You can book your flights with Stars & Maple Holidays.
- **Departure Transfer in Vancouver** – Transfer from your hotel in Denver to Rocky Mountaineer (RMR) Rail Station in Denver is not included in the Rail Package. This is offered as an add-on optional service.
- **Arrival Transfer in Moab** – Transfer from Rocky Mountaineer (RMR) Rail Station in Moab to your hotel in Moab is not included in the Rail Package. This is offered as an add-on optional service. Transfers to downtown Moab from Rocky Mountaineer Station in Moab is included.
- **How far are the journeys on RMR?** - Look forward to spending two or more full relaxing days onboard the Rocky Mountaineer. On Canadian routes, about 450 kilometers (280 miles) each day, all in daylight.
